Required Items

Each camper needs to leave an extra pair of socks
at the center for the duration of the summer. These
are for rain dates, bowling, or roller-skating
activities.

**NO camper will be permitted to participate in
these events if they do not provide the extra pair
of socks at the beginning of Summer Camp.**

Please have all campers bring an extra change of
clothing in a back-pack or other carry-all.

Tennis shoes must be worn or brought to camp for
outside play. Children are **NOT** allowed to play
outside in sandals, flip-flops, open-toed or backless
shoes.

Each child must have their own bottle of
sun-screen. First and last name must be written on
the bottle and handed to the child's counselor. A
paper must be filled out for each bottle. If you need
a paper, please ask.

A Summer Activities Calendar will be handed out at the beginning of each month. If you do not receive one please see your Camp Counselor.

Lunches

The center will **NOT** be providing lunches for campers for the duration of the summer. Each child is required to bring a packed lunch and water bottle every day. Please be sure that your child's name is on both their lunch bag and water bottle. All lunches need to be completely disposable; everything will be thrown away after the meal.
(This includes spoons)

Camp T-Shirts \$15 each

Parents you need to order at least one T-shirt per child! The first T-shirt is free but we still need sizes. (We recommend at least two T-shirts) The child must wear their shirts on all swim days and fieldtrip days or they will not be able to go on the fieldtrip and they can **NOT** stay at the center. We are sorry if this causes a problem, but we do not have enough staff to stay behind.

Important!

Remember to check your calendar for special things!

Campers are responsible for their own belongings. There is to be **NO** cell phones unless authorized. They will be confiscated and given to the parent at the end of the day.

Your children may bring in hand held games, I-pods, and DS's **but they must be approved (music and the type of games played)**. There will be certain times that these will be allowed out to be used; at all other times they will be kept in the child's cubbie. Full participation when attending camp is required, unless there is a doctor's excuse. All campers will be with their designated group and specific counselor during camp.
